Pyrotechnic Fireworks Display Requirements

The following application shall be made not less than 14 days prior to the scheduled date of the display. All displays and materials shall be in accordance with Chapter 33 of the International Fire Code as adopted. This paperwork in no way constitutes other local jurisdiction's approval.

^{*}The permitie shall furnish a current bond or certificate of insurance.

^{*}Provide an accurate diagram of the grounds on which the display is to be held showing the point at which the fireworks are to be discharged; the location of buildings and occupancy type, highways and other lines of communication, the lines behind which the audience will be restrained, and the location of nearby trees, telegraph or telephone lines and other overhead obstructions. Show the proper location of all storage of fireworks and related materials. The designated landing area shall not be within 100 feet of tents, canopies and membrane structures; shall be an approved large, clear, open area; and shall not allow spectators, vehicles, and/or combustible materials. 50 foot trajectory clearance (minimum) is required.
